Police, Sheriffs, Firefighters Endorse Holperin

Three respected professional organizations representing police officers, firefighters, and sheriffs/deputy sheriffs have all endorsed the candidacy of Jim Holperin who is running for State Senate in the 12th District.

“Jim Holperin is the candidate best suited to address the serious economic challenges confronting Wisconsin right now, while still protecting the services that state citizens have come to expect and deserve,” said Jim Palmer, Executive Director of the Wisconsin Professional Police Association (WPPA). “He will fight to keep the state’s fiscal crisis from compromising the quality of public safety services available in our communities.”
